- Have good character and live in a way that is in line with the Bible, <u>Black Rock's</u> <u>Statement of Faith</u>, and the <u>lifestyle agreement</u> laid out by the Black Rock Church Elders and Pastors. New team members will be expected to go through Black Rock's volunteer onboarding process, if they have not done so already, which includes safety training, and a background check.
- Are committed to the <u>Mission, Core Values, and Standards, and Expectations</u> of the Black Rock Worship Ministry.
- Are regular attenders, and part of the Black Rock Church Community (attending for at least 6 months)

Musical skills we look for during the audition process:

Vocalists:

- Sing on pitch
- Can find and sing harmony

Musicians:

- Read chord charts
- Comfortable in any key
- Familiar with chord structure
- Sense of scale when playing with the band: How much to play
- Able to play dynamics: Quiet vs driving
- Good rhythmic sense
