Responsibilities of this role:

- Pursue an intentional and personal spiritual and leadership growth plan with the help of a partnered Community Group Coach.
- Plan, organize and facilitate the weekly, local group gathering during each week of Community Group terms.
- Foster a culture of commitment to a lifestyle of community within the group.
- Lead by example in loving and serving one another and facilitate opportunities for group members to live in this way.
- Develop understanding and insight into the personal faith stories of each group member in order to shepherd and challenge them toward next steps in their faith.
- Collaboratively determine and pursue a locally-focused, gospel-driven missional identity as a group.
- Utilize the Realm online communication tool within your group culture.
- Actively invite and welcome new group members from the local area and foster connection opportunities with the group members' local circles of influence.
- Enable the group to form and sustain intentional connection with a Black Rock global missions partner.
- Develop a growth and multiplication strategy for the group in collaboration with the partnered Community Group Coach.
- Help identify and provide leadership opportunities for emerging group leaders in coordination with the Community Group Coach.
