# About Mission Trips



Black Rock sends teams around the world on mission trips to advance the goals of our Global Partners. They work in places where the gospel is inaccessible, among the poorest of the poor, or with the most vulnerable and exploited.

The aim of mission trips is to help establish churches where none exist and strengthen existing local churches and outreaches that provide continual care and support to those most in need in their communities.

Our desire is that everyone who calls Black Rock Church home, would consider going on a mission trip. Through these trips, you can serve those in need, spread Christ's love to the lost around the world, and experience a life-changing experience with your Black Rock family! We offer trips to multiple countries every year so please consider applying for one of our upcoming trips and let us know of your interest.

## TRAVEL IN A New Reality

Events since 2020 have made conducting mission trips more complicated. These include political and economic unrest in some host countries. Sending teams requires planning for contingencies to safeguard the health and experience of both participants and ministry recipients.

Requirements for each trip will include compliance with each host country and organization's guidelines as well as consideration of travel advisories and advice of our host partners. If the situation in a host country makes it prohibitive for participants to travel and/or be effective in ministry, we reserve the right to cancel a trip.



Join us to serve in Fort Myers, Florida, as BRC partners with Reach Global Crisis Response to assist and bring hope to this community that was devastated by Hurricane Ian on September 28, 2022. Hurricane Ian, a large and destructive Category 4 Atlantic hurricane, was the deadliest hurricane to strike the state of Florida since the 1935 Labor Day hurricane. Ian generated over \$50.2 billion dollars in damage. As they serve, team members will bring the hope and love of Christ by giving their time, talents, and support. This project can use a wide range of skills. Your team leader can help you determine where your skillset will serve best.

This trip will allow you to live and serve among poverty-stricken people in a safe and protected environment. The BRC team will experience great joy as they love on the children of Teupasenti and recondition the CRM feeding center so that the mission can restart the "Jesus and Meal" program in the poor mountain village.

Through morning devotions and personal prayer time, the trip will encourage each team member to develop a closer relationship with Jesus while developing a spiritual bond with other team members.

#### TWO THINGS YOU CAN GET STARTED ON:

- **1. Passports:** If you don't have a valid passport, get one! Processing time takes about 10 weeks so start the process now to be ready to go for any of our international trips. Visit your local post office or go to travel.state. gov to learn more.
- **2. BRC Volunteer Screening Process:** All adults (16+) are required to complete Black Rock's volunteer screening process prior to going on a mission trip. If you're not already serving at Black Rock Church, contact serving@blackrock.org to begin that process.
