# FEATURED Partners

Tohnhull and Stacy Omorefe moved their family to Ghana in 2010 to create City of Refuge Ministries (CORM), serving children rescued from slavery and providing them quality restorative care and education. Their ministry includes working with communities in an effort to prevent child trafficking.



Mary and her sister Dora, rescued from harsh conditions, arrived at CORM 12 years ago. Mary recently graduated and is now interning with CORM's Impact One Social Welfare Dept. After her parents sold her as a child, she ended up in Togo where she witnessed children being mistreated by their masters. She wrote, "some [children] went missing, [some] were killed, and they were treated brutally." She plans to pursue a social work degree to help children and save them from situations like she observed and experienced as a child.



Tustin + Sarah Kropf are passionate about reaching people's hearts with the Gospel in hard-to-reach areas in North Africa, West Africa and the Middle East. They lead a team that trains local leaders through their Bible school and develops media content in French and English for children and adults.



The Kropfs help run a Bible school for indigenous believers training for ministry. The pastor of one of the students recognized the call to ministry on the student's life and encouraged him to enroll. The student graduated strengthened and committed to share the good news about God with his tribe in their own language and soon opened his own school of discipleship.



Hawes Held Training Center is a new initiative of City Ministries, the ministry with which BRC Global Partners Peter and Miriam Fretheim serve in Nigeria. We are excited to partner with them as they build this new facility.

This year, BRC is providing financial support to assist in the building of City Ministries' new Harvest Field Training Center, Through the training center, they will disciple those who have come out of Islam, equipping them to reach their own people with the good news of Jesus. In addition to the construction of classrooms, housing, and offices, this project includes funding of agriculture, farming, and water initiatives to make the facility self-sustaining.

Ton + Valerie Brown work among the Yanomami in the village of Budu-U, Brazil, to make disciples of Christ and establish a reproducing church. Valerie helps run the village school, teaches Bible lessons, and creates materials in the Yanomami language.



God is building His church in the jungle village of Budu-U. Recently, spiritually mature believers traveled from Venezuela into Brazil to encourage believers from Budu-u and other villages. The Venezuelans instructed from God's Word, specifically seeking to correct lingering syncretistic beliefs.

# A Few BRC Missions Goals:

- Support new BRC Global Partners Matt and Mali Hunt who left for Strasbourg, France, in December 2022. They serve in and through a local church, working in refugee ministry and discipling, training, equipping, supporting, and sending out church planters from among unreached people groups who have come to Strasbourg.
- Celebrate our 30-year partnership with MedSend and continue to support their work in areas of the world where healthcare may be the only form of Christian witness access. MedSend empowers healthcare professionals by alleviating the burden of student loan indebtedness and freeing them to serve in areas of deep physical and spiritual need.
- Partner with Erin Duerr as she launches into ministry alongside Peter and Miriam Fretheim and City Ministries in the coming months. With her degree in horticulture, she will help City Ministries' farmlands become a self-sustaining source of food. Additionally, Erin desires to provide nationals ministering in the north with training in arid farming practices so that they have a stable food source.

Florida **JUNE 18-24** 

We are teaming up with Reach Global Crisis Response. Our BRC mission team will support relief so desperately needed after Hurricane Ian left Fort Meyers with vast devastation in September 2022.

Honduras JUNE 24-JULY 1

From a safe, protected environment, the Black Rock mission team will serve the poverty stricken village of Teupasenti. Experience great joy serving the children and working with the "Jesus and Meal" program.

Rwanda JUNE 24-JULY 4

Join the local churches in Rwanda that are alleviating extreme poverty, combating malnutrition, and caring for orphans. We will work with the local church to run a camp for orphans and promote the programs they run. This trip will deepen the way you see God, your faith, and our world.

JUNE 28-JULY 5

Dominican Republic Student JUNE 28-JULY Black Rock partners with Mission of Hope to run a Vacation Bible School and a kids' sports camp, along with helping the church with some construction. This is a great opportunity and experience for students.

Dominican Republic Family

JULY 15-20

This team will be helping Haitian refugees alongside Mission of Hope. Opportunities include construction projects, evangelism, Vacation Bible School and sports camps. This trip is intended to be family friendly.

Kazakhstan **JULY 5-13** 

We will travel to Rudny to work alongside our Christian brothers and sisters from Hope Center and their pastor. We will minister and extend Christ's love as we assist Hope Center with various outreaches that include a soup kitchen; a drug and alcohol rehabilitation center located on a nearby farm; a children's camp; street ministry to the homeless; and a dump ministry.

Luain OCTOBER 2023

We will serve with our Global Partners in Spain who provide a variety of support to Arabic speaking Christians and missionaries working in local ministry to Muslims, including refugees from North Africa.


