

Have you heard of Joshua Project?



It seems lots of people have.

One of this year's spotlight partners, Joshua Project, aims to catalyze church planting among least-reached people groups by highlighting specific data on people and places with the least access or response to the Gospel.

Recently, a Joshua Project team member returned from Asia where over 700 Christian leaders from 342 organizations attended a conference. Two-thirds of the attendees indicated they had heard of Joshua Project. They shared how Joshua Project and their focus on unreached people groups had profoundly influenced them. One delegate mentioned that their work among a large unreached people group started after hearing that there were only 20 believers among that group. "We are now counting over 10,000 believers today! Joshua Project really helped us focus our work!"
