How Medsend Provides Healthcare and Hope



MedSend is addressing the global healthcare crisis through two key pathways: **supporting U.S. healthcare professionals** with financial relief and well-being resources, and **equipping Christian nationals** with medical training and funding to serve their communities. Through generous support over their 32 years MedSend has:

- Approved **700+ grants**, providing over **\$22 million** in funding.
- Paid off **172 educational loans**, freeing medical professionals for mission work.
- Supported 137 U.S. missionary families and 55 National Scholars in the field.
- Reached 5 million people with the Good News of Jesus in 53 countries, impacting over 1 billion in underserved communities.
