- We will ask you to run either the 8:30am service or the 10:00am and 11:30am services.

Importance of this role

The Light Board Operator is charged with changing the light cues between the elements of a Sunday service. The lighting design each week enhances the worship experience for those worshiping in the Worship Center and online.

Sign up process

Responsibilities of this role

- The Light Board Operator will be responsible for changing the light cues between service elements, including during the worship sets, announcements, the sermon and videos.
- Although the cues will be pre-programmed, the Light Board Operator may be asked to bring the house lights up or down more during a service.

Preferred attributes

- Servant heart
- Excitement to worship God through serving our congregation, both for those worshiping in the Worship Center and for those watching online
- Attention to detail
- Some IT/tech skills preferred, BUT NOT REQUIRED we can train you!

Prerequisites & Expectations

- Completion of the Volunteer Screening Process *required for all volunteers
- Must be attending BRC for at least 6 months

Training

- Hands on training during at least one Wednesday night band rehearsal
- Separate training, most likely on a Saturday morning, to walk through some troubleshooting techniques and possibly to talk through the design process if that interests you
- Shadowing a team member for 1-2 Sundays
- Operating the light board with a staff or team leader shadowing for at least one Sunday
