- Sunday, 8:30am Service: please arrive by 8:00am.
- Sunday, 10:00am & 11:30am Services: please arrive by 9:30am.
- For special events, like Christmas and Easter, we will ask you to attend rehearsal before the event.
- We will ask you to attend the Wednesday night rehearsal and run both the 10:00am & 11:30am services on Sunday morning. We will also ask you to program for the 8:30am service and run that service as well. If that is not possible, we will do our best to accommodate your schedule.

Importance of this role

The Light Board Programmer is charged with designing and programming the light cues for the services. The lighting design each week enhances the worship experience for those worshipping in the Worship Center and online.

Responsibilities of this role

- The Light Board Operator will be responsible for programming the light cues between service elements, including during the worship sets, announcements, the sermon and videos.

- Attention to detail
- Some IT/tech skills preferred, BUT NOT REQUIRED - we can train you!

Prerequisites & Expectations

- Completion of the Volunteer Screening Process ****required for all volunteers***
- Must be attending BRC for at least 6 months

Training

- Hands on training during at least two Wednesday night band rehearsals
- Separate training to walk through the process of programming cues and the design process - use of fixtures, presets, etc.
- Programming with the Team Leader shadowing you for 1-2 rehearsals
- Operating the light board with a staff or team leader shadowing for at least one Sunday



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
